



What you need to know about the General Election that will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

***This is an extremely important election. Your VOTE is your voice.
Take the time to VOTE!!!!***

Last day to register is October 5, 2020.

Early Voting: October 13, 2020 through October 30, 2020. ***(COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES IN AFFECT)***

***Voting Hours: October 13 thru October 17 (8:00 am to 5:00 pm); October 19 thru October 23 (8:00 am to 5:00 pm);
October 24 (7:00 am to 7:00 pm); October 25 (11:00 am to 4:00 pm); October 26 to 30 (7:00 am to 7:00 pm)***

Election Day: November 3, 2020 – 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. ***(COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES IN AFFECT)***

Don't forget to bring an Acceptable Form of Photo Identification.

Except for the U.S. Citizenship Certificate, for voters aged 18-69, the acceptable form of photo identification must be current or have expired no more than 4 years. Persons 70 years of age or older may use a form of acceptable photo identification that has expired if the identification is otherwise valid.

- Texas Driver License issued by the Department of Public Safety (DPS);
 - Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS;
 - Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS;
 - Texas Handgun License issued by DPS;
- United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph;
- United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph; or
 - United States Passport (book or card).

There is no longer straight ticket voting. Each candidate must be selected individually. If your candidate is not listed on the ballot, you do not have to select the alternate candidate.

Closer to the Election you can go to this site to print out your sample ballot to see who you want to represent you. This can be brought into the Polling Center for reference, but not shared with other voters while in the Polling Center.

To be eligible to Vote by Mail in Texas, you must:

- be 65 years or older;
- be disabled;
- be out of the county on election day and during the period for early voting by personal appearance; or
- be confined in jail, but otherwise eligible

There are three ways to get an **Application for Ballot by Mail (ABBM)**:

- **Fillable .pdf version** – print on both sides and mail to Early Voting Clerk, PO Box 961011, Fort Worth, TX 76161

Applications must be RECEIVED by the Early Voting Clerk on or before Friday, October 23, 2020. Last day for Elections to Receive Ballot by Mail – November 4, 2020 if postmarked by November 3, 2020
